Welcome back, I hope you all had a fantastic break!

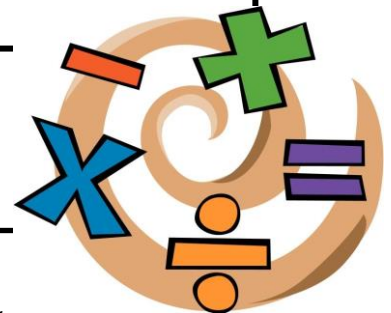
As I am sure you are aware, the Key Stage 2 SATs are just around the corner.

Maths

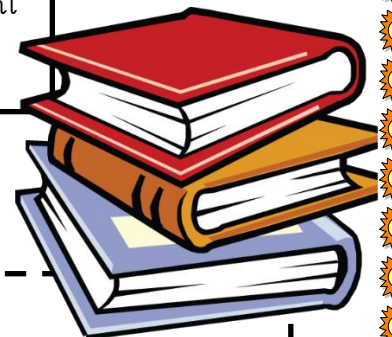
Similar to last half term, we will be using some of our afternoon sessions to complement our morning Mathematics sessions.

We will be exploring all aspects of Mathematics including number and place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages, statistics, geometry and algebra. As well as this, we will be working on SATs style questions and practising techniques for the test in May.



English

This term the children will be continuing to focus on enhancing their grammar skills within their writing. This will include: exploring different types of nouns, different sentence types, adjectival and adverbial phrases, active and passive voice as well as punctuation. We will also be exploring different genres of writing, producing instructions, leaflets and a recount about our trip to Mount Cook.
